In 2014, he obtained a PhD in Veterinary Sciences with research focused on systemic inflammatory response syndrome (SIRS), further strengthening his interest in critical care and complex disease processes.

Marcin is a founding member and President of the Polish Association of Veterinary Emergency and Critical Care (PAVECC), where he actively supports the advancement of ECC education and professional development. He has completed ESAVS Level I and II training in Emergency and Critical Care and is a member of both VECCS and EVECCS.

A regular participant and speaker at national and international conferences, Marcin is committed to promoting high standards of emergency and critical care medicine and has authored and co-authored numerous scientific and professional publications.
