
Welcome to Gothenburg!

Hosting you in the heart of Sweden equidistant to the three capitals of Sweden, Denmark and Norway – <u>Stockholm</u>, <u>Copenhagen</u> and <u>Oslo</u>, the congress will take place in the **Swedish Exhibition & Congress Centre** (*Svenska Mässan - Gothia towers*)

Within the excellent exhibit space of one of Europe's best conference venue's; The centre has nine exhibition halls, 60 meeting rooms (from 2 to 8,800 guests), a congress hall for 1,500 people, eight restaurants, five bars and Scandinavia's largest hotel, <u>Gothia Towers</u>. The centre has an area of $41,000 \text{ m}^2$ (440,000 sq ft) for exhibitions and congresses,



The central location also places the venue within walking distance of hotels, restaurants, pubs, shopping malls and theatres. Winner of numerous awards for congress's hotel and catering over the last few years a venue also recognised for its sustainability credentials.


The three-story building, comprises a rectangular plan, divided into four articulated-wings, covered in differentiated tile. The principal facade is oriented to the south, corresponding to the wharf's customshouse.

Host city

Gothenburg is the second-largest city in Sweden, fifth-largest in the Nordic countries, with a population of approximately 1.1 million inhabitants in the metropolitan area.

Founded in 1621 rich in history Gothenburg is now also an academic city home to nearly 40000 students, as the city includes the University of Gothenburg. The Global Destination Sustainability Index has named Gothenburg the world's most sustainable destination every year since 2016 and it was named one of the top 2020 European Capitals of Smart Tourism.







Situated on Sweden's scenic west coast, Gothenburg exudes an open spirit with a sustainability ethos that runs through the city's sights and attractions. Founded by King Gustav II Adolf, Sweden's second city soon established itself as a commercial fishing and shipbuilding hub, and later as a leader in transport innovation.

The city of Gothenburg has extensive experience in hosting and organizing large and small meetings and events. A well developed and functioning network between cities, universities, businesses, and organizations enables fast and professional turnkey solutions.







As a centre for gastronomy, it also boasts 18 restaurants listed in the Michelin Guide, with 5 restaurants awarded stars. Gothenburg is also home to several dishes from traditional Swedish cuisine. Some typical dishes from this city are shrimp sandwiches, Halv Special (a Swedish hot dog), Mackerell, Cinamon buns and Hönökaka (a flat soft white pricked sweat bread)

Göteborg Landvetter Airport (GOT)

Göteborg Landvetter Airport (GOT) is located 24 kilometers to the east of Gothenburg, in the locality of Landvetter. It is the second largest airport in Sweden and in 2021, the Airport handled over 7.5 million passengers. Scandinavian Airlines, Air France, KLM, Lufthansa, British Airways and many others fly regularly to and from this Airport, as well as low-cost carriers such as Ryanair, SunExpress and TUI.

Taxis wait outside the arrivals hall of the airport. There are different companies that provide taxi services to and from Gothenburg Airport. They will get you to the city centre within less than 25 minutes. The journey between the Airport and a centrally located accommodation costs approximately $\in 35 - \notin 40$.
