

Walking through the city feels like stepping into a living museum—yet one that hums with contemporary energy.

At the top of the Royal Mile, you'll find Edinburgh Castle, an awe-inspiring fortress that dominates the skyline and has watched over the city for more than 900 years. Below, the winding streets of the Old Town reveal layers of history, from the mysterious underground vaults to the Palace of Holyroodhouse, the official Scottish residence of the monarch.

Just a short stroll away lies the lush green expanse of Holyrood Park and the dramatic summit of Arthur's Seat, an extinct volcano that offers panoramic views over the city and beyond. Flying to Edinburgh is quick, easy, and well-connected. Edinburgh Airport (EDI) is Scotland's busiest airport, welcoming direct flights from over 150 destinations across Europe, North America, and the Middle East. Major airlines like British Airways, KLM, Lufthansa, Ryanair, and easyJet offer regular services, making the city highly accessible for international and domestic travelers alike. The airport is just 30 minutes from the city centre by tram, bus, or taxi, ensuring a smooth arrival experience.

Airlink 100 Bus

- **Frequency**: Every 10 minutes, 24/7.
- **Duration**: Approximately 30 minutes to the city centre.
- **Stops**: Major stops include Haymarket, Princes Street, and Waverley Bridge.
- Fare: Single ticket £5.50; return ticket £8.
- **Payment**: Tickets can be bought online, at the airport, or directly from the driver (contactless accepted).

Bright Bus Airport Express

- **Frequency**: Regular services throughout the day.
- **Duration**: Approximately 30 minutes to the city centre.
- Stops: Stops include Edinburgh Zoo, Haymarket, and Princes Street.
- Fare: Single ticket £4.50; return ticket £7.50.
- **Payment**: Tickets available online or from the driver.

≜ Taxi

- **Duration**: Approximately 25–30 minutes, depending on traffic.
- Fare: Typically ranges from £25 to £30.
- Availability: Taxis are readily available at the airport's designated taxi rank.

Uber is also available in Edinburgh, so please check your app for the most accurate rates and fairs onsite.

西 Tram

- **Frequency**: Every 7 minutes between 7:00 AM and 7:00 PM; every 10 minutes during early mornings and evenings.
- **Operating Hours**: First tram departs the airport at 6:26 AM; last tram at 10:48 PM.
- **Duration**: Approximately 35 minutes to the city centre.
- **Stops**: Key stops include Haymarket, Princes Street, and St Andrew Square.
- **Fare**: Single ticket £7; return ticket £9.50.
- **Payment**: Tickets can be purchased at machines on the platform or via contactless payment.

Note: A new contactless payment system, "tap on, tap off" (ToTo), is set to launch on May 19, 2025, allowing passengers to use contactless cards or devices for fare payment, with daily and weekly caps applied.

❷ Train

- **Access**: Take the tram from the airport to Edinburgh Gateway station (approximately 7 minutes), then transfer to a train heading to the city centre.
- **Duration**: Total journey time is around 30 minutes.
- Fare: Varies depending on the train company and service.
