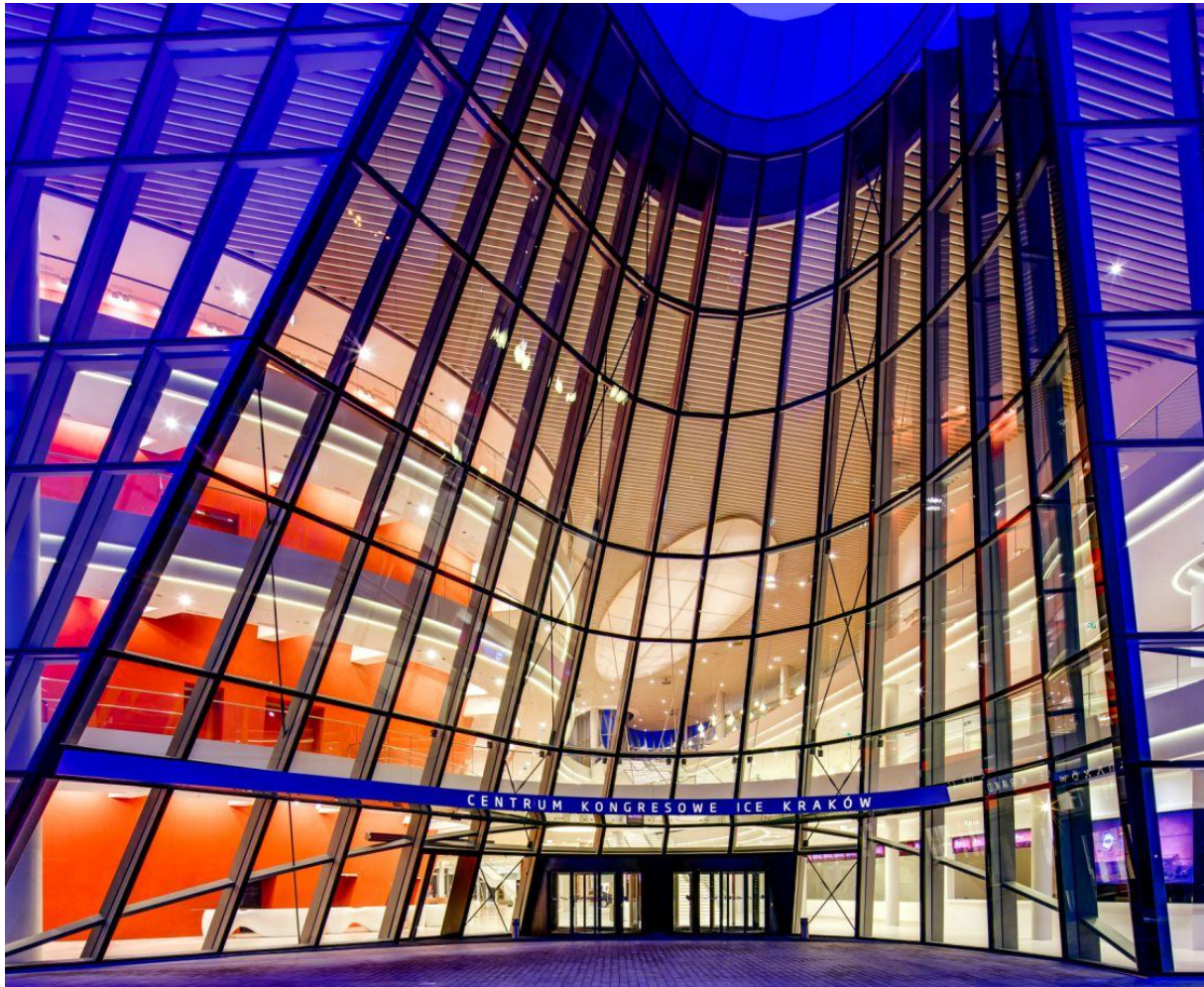

Experience Kraków: a city of history, heritage, and living culture

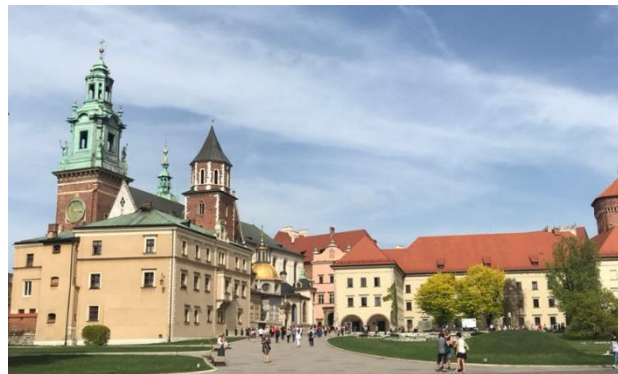
Kraków, one of Poland's most captivating cities, is a place where centuries of history blend seamlessly with vibrant contemporary life. Formerly the royal capital of Poland, Kraków offers visitors a rich and unforgettable experience. The city's origins date back to the 4th century, so whether visiting for a congress, cultural discovery or exploration, Kraków offers a rich and unforgettable experience.

Recognised as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, Kraków's historic centre is among the best-preserved medieval city cores in Europe. At its heart lies the Main Market Square (Rynek Główny), one of the largest medieval squares on the continent, surrounded by historic townhouses, churches and lively cafés. Wandering through the Old Town reveals layers of architecture and history that reflect Kraków's importance as a political, cultural and academic centre for over a thousand years.

Dominating the city skyline is Wawel Hill, crowned by the Wawel Royal Castle and Cathedral. This iconic complex served as the residence of Polish kings for centuries and remains one of the most significant cultural symbols of Poland. From here, visitors can enjoy views over the Vistula River, which gently winds through the city and provides scenic walking routes along its banks.

Just beyond the Old Town lies Kazimierz, Kraków's historic Jewish Quarter, now revitalised into one of the city's most dynamic cultural districts. Known for its synagogues, galleries, music venues and independent restaurants, Kazimierz offers a unique atmosphere that combines history, creativity and modern urban life.

Kraków is also renowned for its strong academic tradition, anchored by the Jagiellonian University, founded in 1364 and one of the oldest universities in Europe. This long-standing scholarly heritage contributes to the city's international outlook and youthful energy, creating an environment where tradition and innovation coexist.

Beyond its landmarks, Kraków is a destination for the senses. The city's culinary scene reflects both Polish tradition and contemporary influences. Visitors can enjoy classic dishes such as pierogi, żurek and obwarzanek, alongside modern interpretations of regional cuisine and an increasingly diverse restaurant culture with 22 restaurants in the Michelin guide. Local cafés, cellar restaurants and historic taverns add to the city's distinctive charm.

Kraków Airport (KRK)

Flying to Kraków is convenient and well connected. Kraków John Paul II International Airport (KRK) is one of Poland's busiest airports and a key gateway to southern Poland, offering direct flights to numerous destinations across Europe and selected long-haul routes. A wide range of international and low-cost airlines, including LOT Polish Airlines, Lufthansa, Ryanair, easyJet and KLM, provide regular services, ensuring excellent accessibility for both international and domestic travellers. The airport is located approximately 15 kilometres from the city centre and can be reached in around 20–30 minutes by train, bus or taxi, offering a smooth and efficient arrival experience.
